

### Illness Policy

We would like to thank all of our parents for helping keep your children, teachers and your child's friends healthy. We have had a fairly successful cold and flu season but it is not over yet. This is all in cooperation of all our families and staff in following a healthy practice of keeping your sick children at home. For ease of reference our policy is listed below:

- If your child has a fever (100°F or 38?C), diarrhea or vomiting they need to stay home for 24 hours after their symptoms are gone without the aid of medication.
- If your child does require medication while at the center please let your child's teacher know and they will help you fill out the correct medication form.
- All medication must come in the original packaging with the entire prescription and doctors information.

Please remember if your child is well enough to attend our center then they must be well enough to participate in all our activities, including going outside.

# **Outdoor Clothing**

Our January weather as usual has given us a mix of weather! Please send your child with clothing for the variety of outdoor conditions snow pants and/or splash pants, a couple pairs of mittens, hat, jacket.

Your child also needs a complete change of clothing for when we get wet or dirty.

### Picking up, dropping off and the BMCDC Entrance

Pick up and drop off times are very busy periods of the day. Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us.

When dropping off your child please help them hang up their belongings in their cubby and their boots on their boot rack or their designated space.

Please arrive allowing your child enough time to clean up their mess at the end of the day. When picking up your child ensure you have made contact with your child's teacher by speaking with them directly, making eye contact, wave or even have your child inform their teacher prior to leaving. This is especially important when picking up from gym or as the children are arriving back at the center from outside.

### School PD Days & Teachers Convention

Edmonton Public schools have a PD day on Monday February 6th and Edmonton Catholic schools have a PD day on Tuesday February 7th. On each of these days we will be visiting our community library and Safeway in Riverbend Square. If your child would like to check out a book or two, have them come with their library card.

There is no school on Thursday, March 2nd and Friday, March 3rd for Teachers Convention. We will be planning fieldtrips these days and will send out permission forms by email as soon as the fieldtrips have been confirmed. Any suggestions you may have are welcome!
